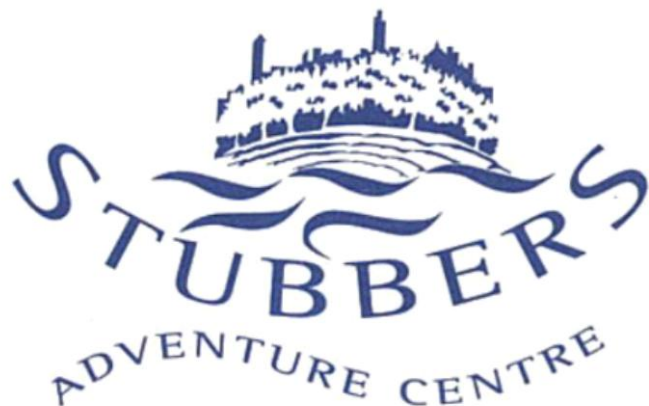

- Our range of activities include jet skiing, sailing, canoeing, kayak, banana rides, climbing, abseiling, high ropes, tunnelling, quad biking, archery, fencing, rifle shooting and mountain boarding.
- At Stubbers you'll find an unrivalled choice of adventure activities and water sports. With over 20 years experience teaching outdoor activities and having fun, you'll be in great hands. The enthusiastic and dedicated team of instructors will make sure you have an exciting weekend.
- Experience the thrill of a jet ski, banana boat or mountain board ride. Take the challenge of the climbing and abseiling tower, brave the high ropes course or crawl through our tunnel challenge. Sail in one of our fleet of single or double handed dinghies, canoe or kayak on one of our 3 lakes. Try archery, fencing or rifle shooting.
- The centre is ideally situated to the North East of London where the suburbs become greenbelt countryside. Upminster tube station is only 5 minutes from the centre and 25 minutes from London on the District Line. The M25 is a mere 10 minutes drive away leaving at junction 29 and the Dartford crossing a short 15-minute drive.



### How It Will Work

### What You Will Need

All groups attending the event must have adequate staff and personnel to support the participants. Depending on which package you choose you may need your own camping equipment and food.

### Accommodation

Tent village accommodation is in bungalow type frame tents each with 8 fitted bunk beds, and plenty of floor space. Each village has a 60-foot marquee complete with wooden floor, kitchen units, tables and benches, along with an electricity supply. Stubbers accommodation can only be booked in groups of 8 young people male or female. Groups with less than 8 may have to share.

# **Group Leader Information**

Every group participating in the event must be self-sufficient and have a nominated group leader to be the main point of contact for event staff. The event is run by a team of qualified instructors, responsible for the overall co-ordination of a well-organised and safe event for the groups to participate in. Each group leader is responsible for their group's own operation and welfare.

Each group leader must:

- Be responsible for the safety and welfare for the members of the group
- Ensure that the group behaves responsibly at all times
- Ensure attendance at the evening briefing meetings
- Ensure that the group acts responsibly and legally in relation to the consumption of alcohol and other substances
- Hold on-site consent forms containing personal and health information on each of their group members
- Provide first aid cover for their group
- Provide all members of their group with relevant information from this information pack
- Ensure that their young people are supervised at all times, particularly during the evenings on site, a min ratio 1:10 and will have not touched any alcoholic substance.
- Make all participants and leaders aware of the 'event charter', included in this pack, taking responsibility for the group's actions and consequences of their actions both on and off the water

# Booking Form

- When booking please ensure that you place the ratio of Males and Females on form.
- If booking Stubbers Tents ratio is Max 8 persons per tent, young persons only, no mixed sharing.
- Sharing with other clubs may have to occur.
- Staff who wish to use the catering of EBGC.
- Staff **MUST** bring own Tents.
- **If using On Site catering we MUST know dietary requirements two weeks before the event.**
