Maes y Lade is a converted Welsh Hill farm situated in 4 acres of isolated rural countryside at the foot of the Black Mountains within the Brecon Beacons National Park in Wales.

An area of outstanding natural beauty, it is within easy reach of the River Wye and limestone systems to the south containing some of the most extensive cave systems in Britain, as well as both natural and quarried climbing sites.

Now an Adventure and Activity Centre, **Maes y Lade caters for:**

The centre can cater for up to 60 people.

The Barn is the largest building with dormitories to accommodate 27 people. The kitchen and dining room can cater for up to 60 people at one sitting. There is also a communal lounge area and drying room.

The Farmhouse is one of the original buildings and accommodates 17 people in dormitories. The ground floor contains a meeting room and conservatory with views across the decked veranda to the valley. Kitchen facilities and dining room space are also available.

The Yurt provides extra accommodation on site that comfortably sleeps 12 people. Extra tents can also be arranged on request.

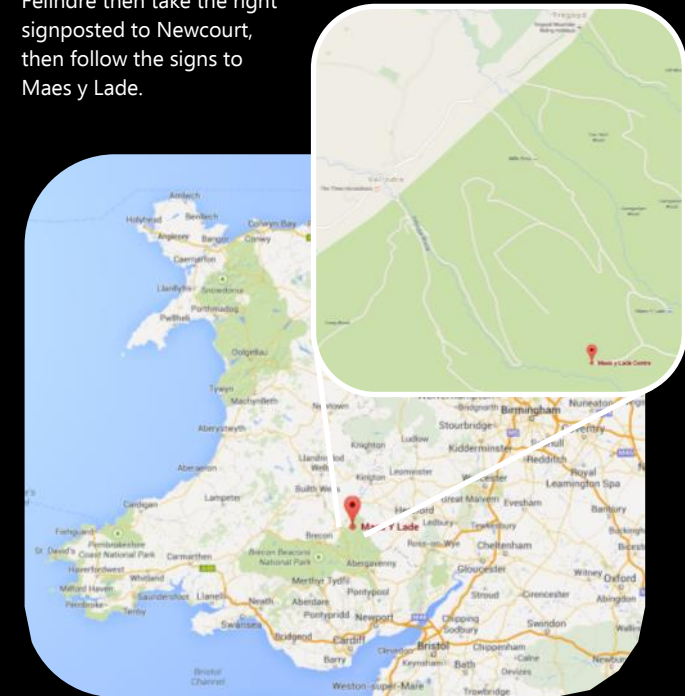


how to find us.

The centre is in the North-East of the Brecon Beacons National Park, home of waterfalls, forests, market towns and the highest peak in southern Britain.

- 2 miles from Felindre village
- 4 miles from Glasbury village
- 5.6 miles from Hay-on-Wye, home of the Hay Literary Festival.

From Essex, take the M25, then M4 to J24, then A449 North to Raglan, then A40 West, then A479 North, then A4078 North, then take the right signed for Felindre & Tregoyd. Drive through Felindre then take the right signposted to Newcourt, then follow the signs to Maes y Lade.
