REP CRICKET TRIAL (07/03/15) @ Frenford Clubs. Our Rep Cricket Trials are open to all young cricketers in the U12 and the U14 age groups. All players who trial will play at least 1 representative game in the season. We take teams to play the top public schools in the country. Fixtures this year include: Eton, Harrow, Tonbridge, Uppingham, Kimbolton, Winchester, Chigwell and Felsted.

CRICKET CAMP (10-12/04/15) @ Gosfield School. The Cricket Camp is a 3 day residential coaching clinic held at Gosfield School. Participants will stay in the dormitories at the school and during the days take part in intensive coaching sessions. Each year guest coaches are invited to run one or more days of the camp. This year Ian Pont will be running one of the days. Formerly bowling coach for Bangladesh, Ian has worked with some of the world's best bowlers including Dale Steyn, Shoaib Akthtar, Darren Gough, Saeed Ajmal and many more.

STREET CRICKET (DATE/VENUE TBC). EBGC runs a Street Cricket tournament each year for U13s. Usually this is an indoor tournament which happens pre-season. This year however EBGC will be looking to develop this event and hold it later in the summer as a cricket festival, potentially running it along with a hard ball 6 aside tournament for older age groups. This will be decided in consultation with affiliated cricket clubs.
