
We are a provider of challenging activities, events and targeted youth projects, with a team of experienced youth workers, outdoor instructors and sports coaches.

In 2004 EBGC obtained a ten year lease to High Row, a bunk house in the Lake District (Since purchased in 2015) and in 2014 EBGC purchased Meas Y Lade, a residential Outdoor activity Centre in the Brecon Beacons - Wales.


