NYA Guidance

We are now officially in Step 2 of the roadmap out of lockdown which means great things for the youth sector! From 12th April 2021, any young person under the age of 18 are now able to come back to youth clubs with no limitation on group sizes. This is of course dependent on the venue still being COVID secure and having all precautions in place. Over 11's must still wear a face covering in an indoor space unless exempt. The rules are staying the same for young people over the age of 18 meaning that they can still be a part of support groups by invitation only in bubbles of up to 15 young people.

D of E



Active Essex Funding

We are excited to say that we partnered with Active Essex again over the Easter holidays and were able to offer face-toface activity sessions in 5 different venues across Essex. In total we had 175 young people take part, 56 across 2 venues in Uttlesford, 54 in Colchester, and 65 across 2 venues in Chelmsford. In these sessions we delivered 4 hours worth of engaging activities over 8 days of the holidays with a variety of healthy snacks and lunch provided to each young person every day. We also handed out food parcels and an activity booklet to each family to use over the holidays.

Kickstart

Essex Boys and Girls Clubs is a part of the new Government Kickstart Scheme which creates employment opportunities for 16-24 year old's to build skills and help them in to long term employment. We will be offering a range of 6 month, 25 hours per week placements for individuals aged between 16-24 years old who are in receipt of Universal Credit. The available placements include Admin Support, Arts Development, Club Development, Fundraising, Media & Marketing, Outdoor Activity Instructing, Sports Coaching & Development, and Youth Club Support. These roles are now live and we are actively seeking individuals.
